DIRECTIONS:

If you want backs, print Page 1. Then Put the paper back in with the same orientation, but make sure the paper is flipped over to print the backs. Depending on your printer, this may take a few tries! It helps if your printer supports double-sided copies.

Otherwise, print 1-sided.

If you print them out on heavy paper they may last longer.

Laminate if possible for better wear.

IDEAS FOR USING THE CARDS:

These are just a few suggestions for using these cards. Come up with your own ideas to get even more fun and use out of them.

- **KNOW YOUR CARDS:** Draw a card. Practice saying the picture/words on the cards. Check your answers on the back.
- **SORT YOUR CARDS:** Say the cards and sort them into categories. You make up the categories.
- **CARD SEARCH:** Try to find examples of what is on the cards in books, on the walls, or around you. Keep two piles of the cards, 1 for the shapes you found and 1 for the shapes you did not find. Or, display all the cards on the table. As you search and find them, turn them over.
- **USE YOUR WORDS:** Choose a card at random. Use the word/idea in a sentence, or describe the picture in a sentence.
