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## **DIRECTIONS:**

## **IDEAS FOR USING THE CARDS:**

These are just a few suggestions for using these cards. Come up with your own ideas to get even more fun and use out of them.

- **KNOW YOUR WORDS:** Draw a card. Practice saying the color words on the cards.
- **SORT YOUR WORDS:** Say the words and sort them into categories, like: light colors, dark colors, reddish colors, etc... You make up the categories.
- **COLOR SEARCH:** Look in an art book or magazine. Find as many of these colors as you can in the pages/pictures. Keep two piles of the cards, 1 for the colors you found and 1 for the colors you did not find. Or, display all the cards on the table. As you search and find them, turn them over.
- **USE YOUR WORDS:** Choose a card at random. Say something that is the color you chose.
