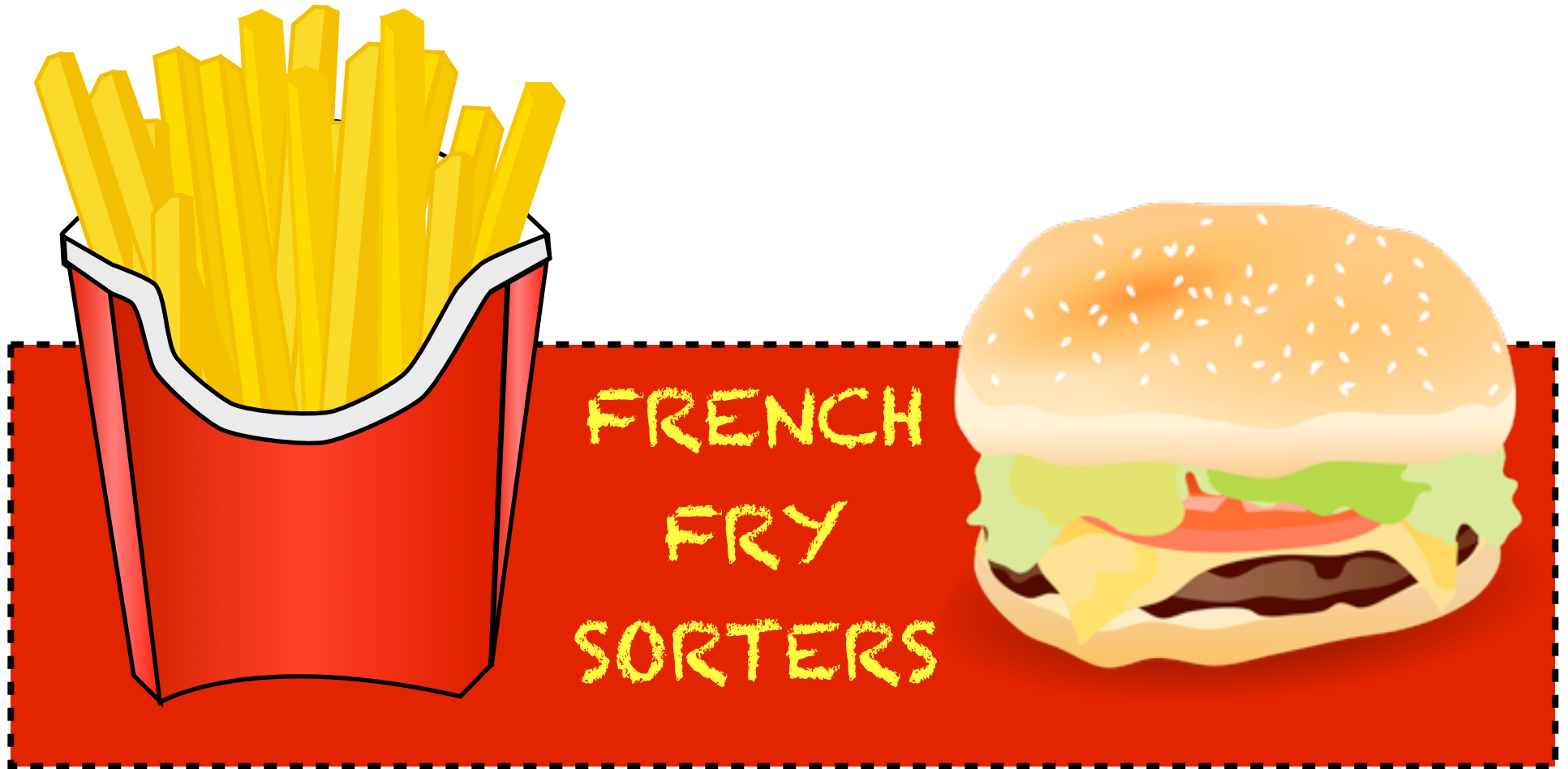
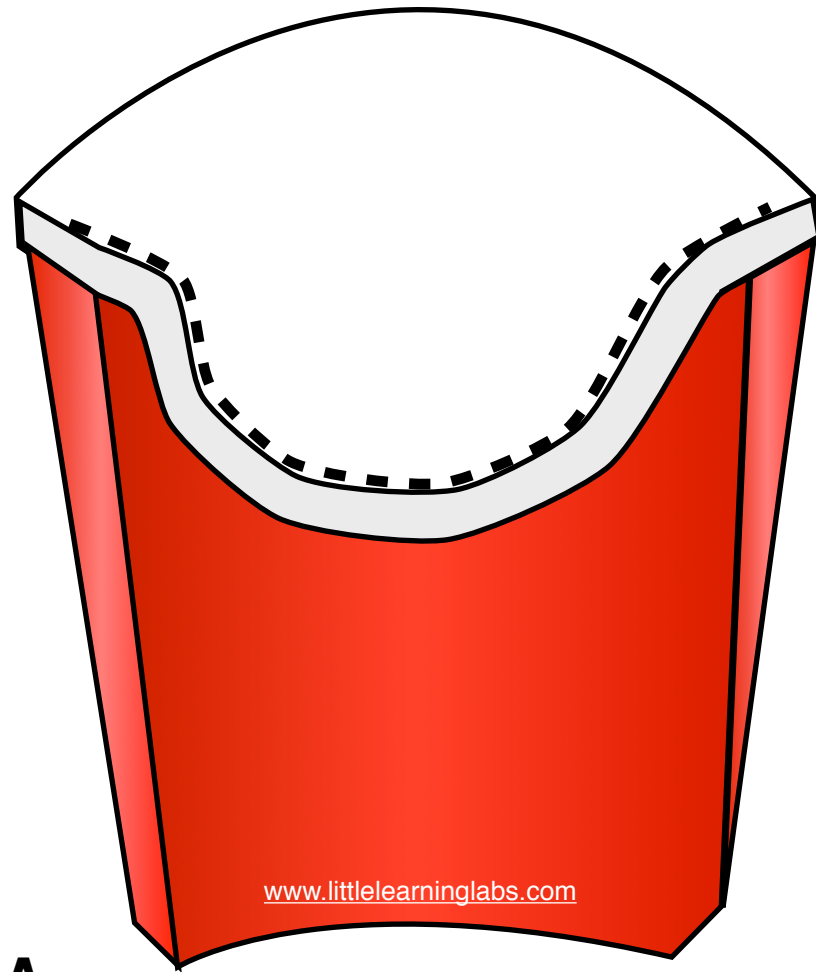
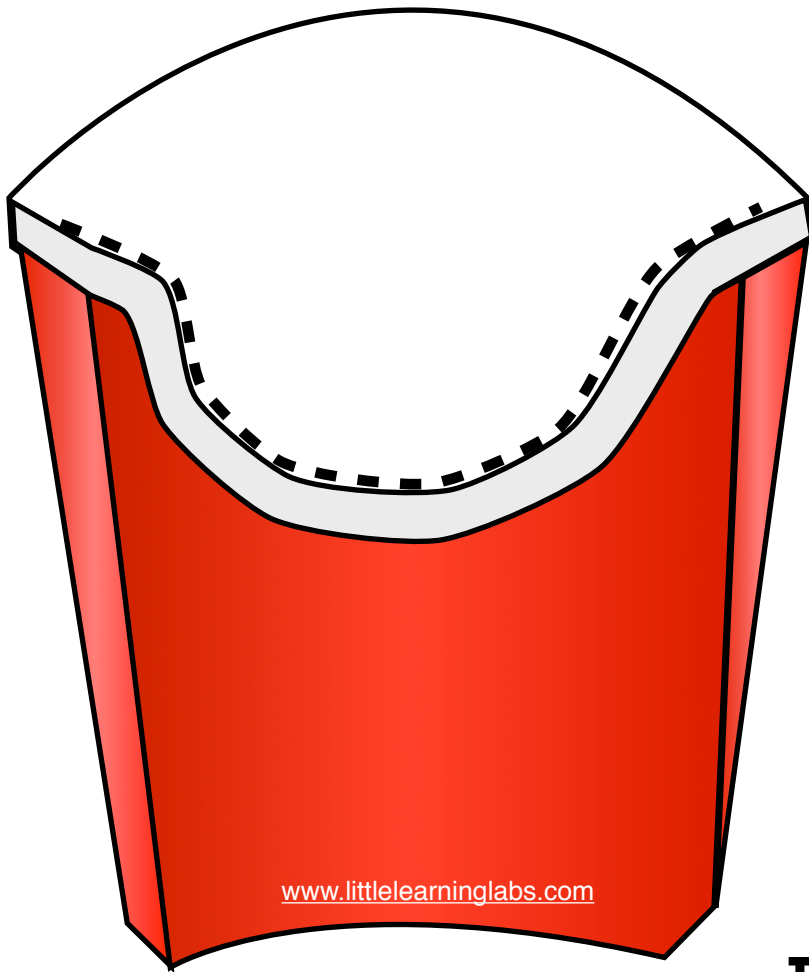

DIRECTIONS:

Print the french fry boxes. Make as many as you need. These ones are blank, without category labels. You can still write on them with a marker if you need to.

Cut on the dotted line after cutting out the main part of the box. This is where you will tuck the fries in, like a pocket. Be careful not to cut too far and slice off the top of the box.

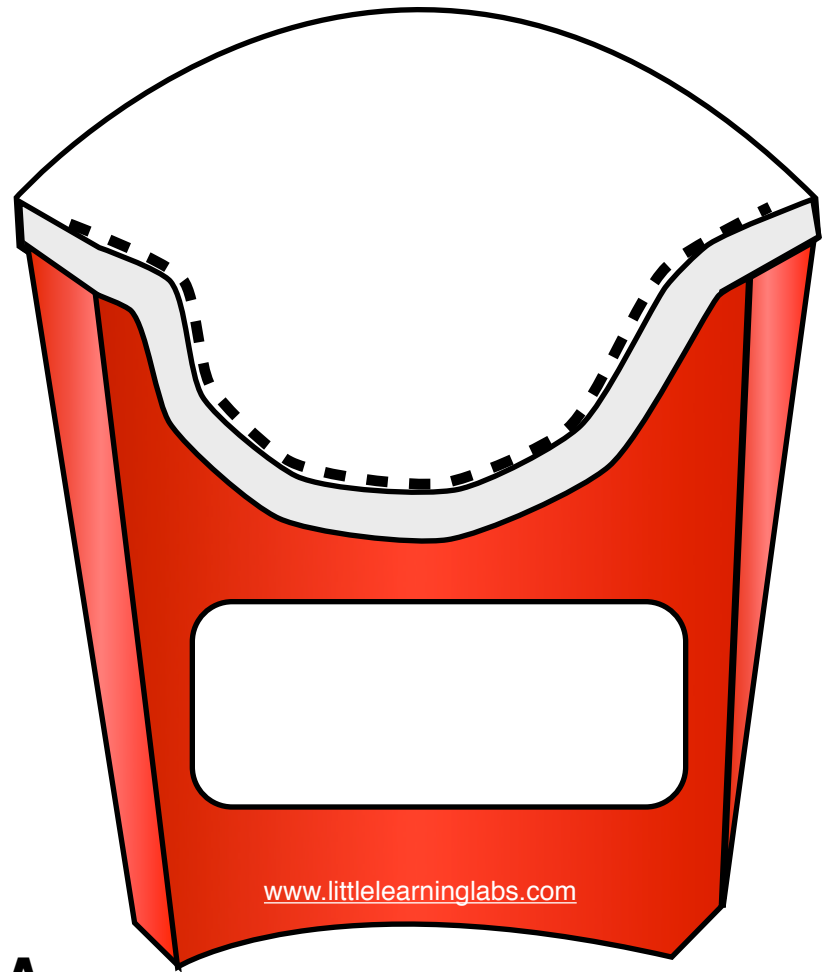
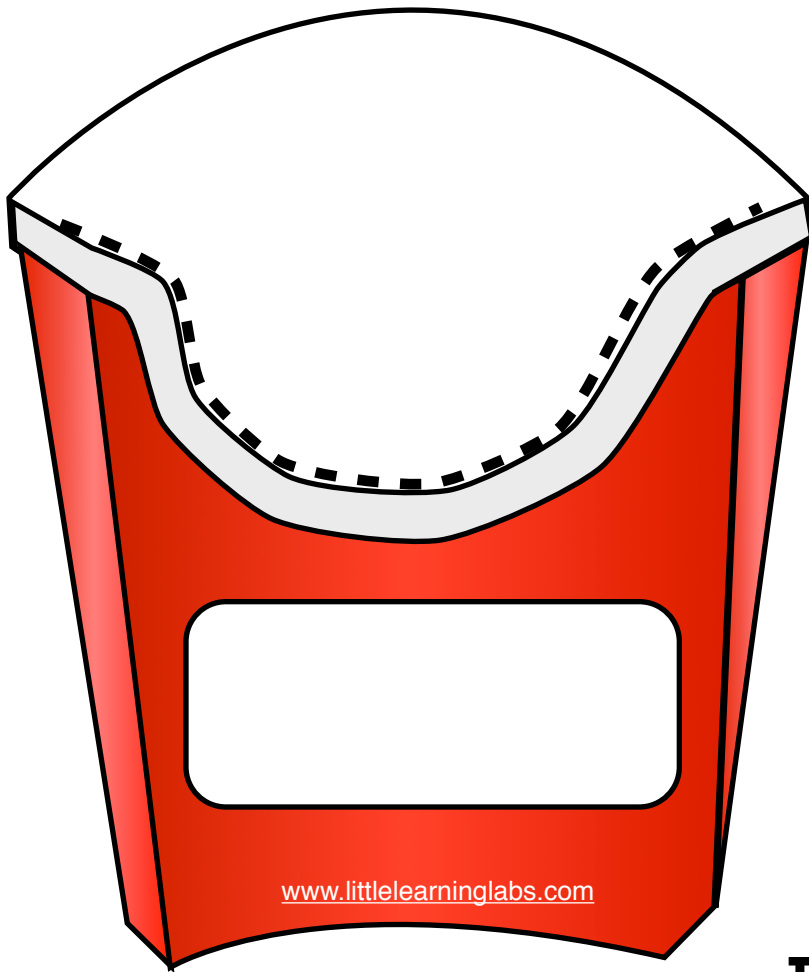

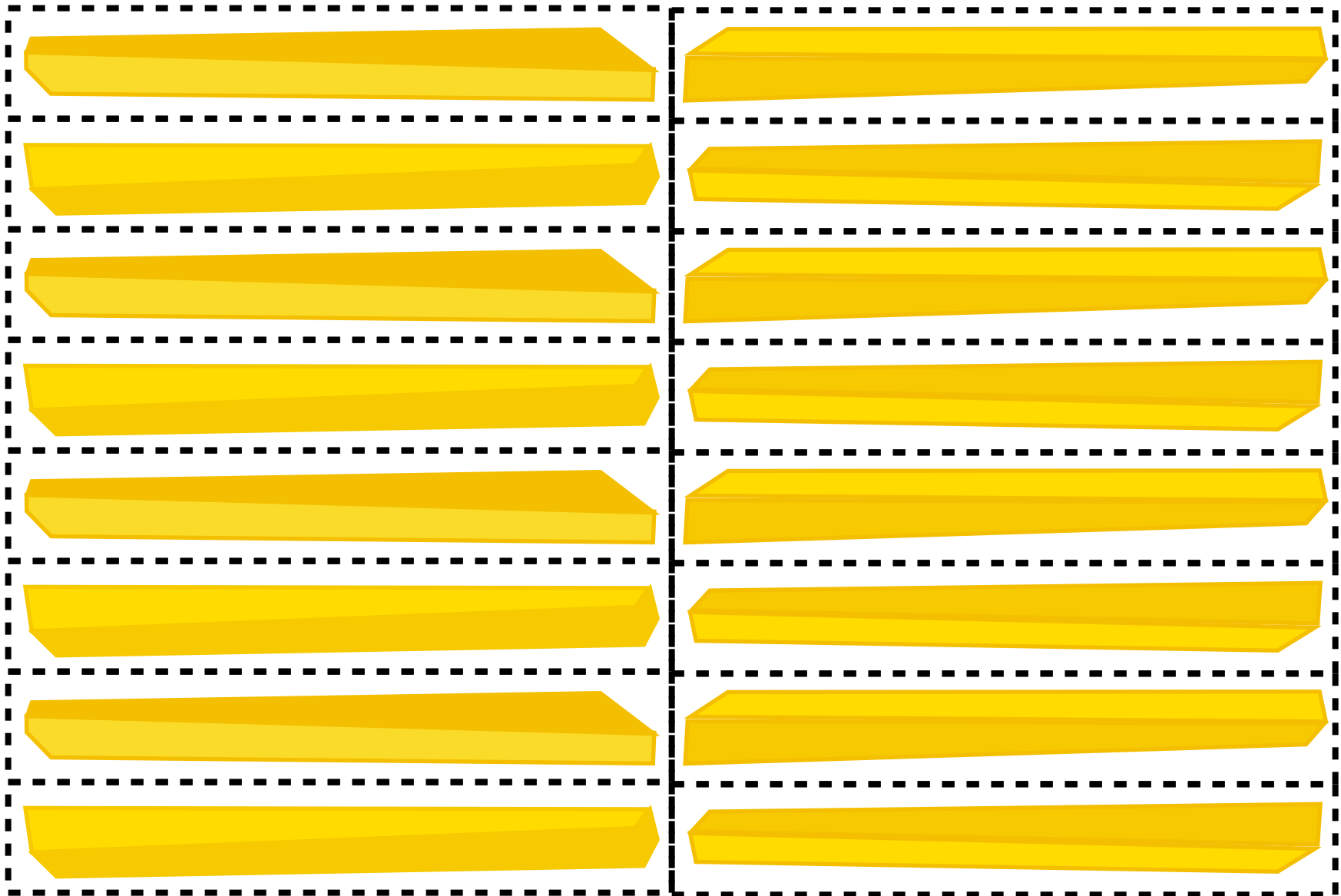

DIRECTIONS:

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DIRECTIONS FOR FRY BOXES:

Print the french fry boxes. Make as many as you need. There are two designs, either with or without a white labeling area. You can still write on them with a marker if you need to. Otherwise, print the ones with white label boxes and write a category name on them.

Cut on the dotted line after cutting out the main part of the box. This is where you will tuck the fries in, like a pocket. Be careful not to cut too far and slice off the top of the box.

DIRECTIONS FOR FRIES:

Print out as many french fries as you need. Either cut along the dotted lines, or close along the edges of the french fries. Write hints, clues, vocabulary words, or whatever you are studying on the front or the backs of the fries. Sort them into the fry boxes.

IDEAS FOR USING THE CARDS:

These are just a few suggestions for using this set. Come up with your own ideas to get even more fun and use out of them.

- **SORTING SOUNDS:** Have students sort out words by sounds, like long or short vowels, parts of speech, etc...
- **SORTING MATH:** Have students sort out math problems by answers, sort equivalent fractions, etc...
- **SORTING BY CONCEPT:** Have students classify or sort major topics, such as first/secondhand accounts, books by genre, types of animals, etc...
- **BULLETIN BOARDS:** Have students put their own french fries into boxes to show how they go home at the end of the day, if they have their homework done, to do attendance, when their birthday is, etc...
