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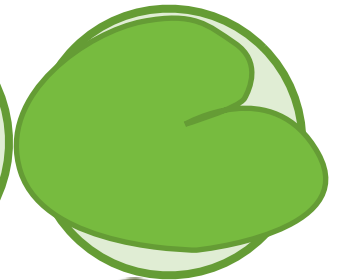
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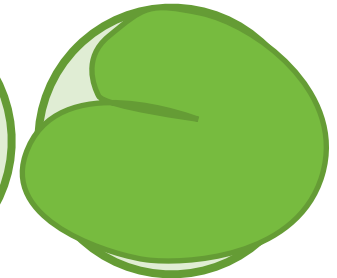
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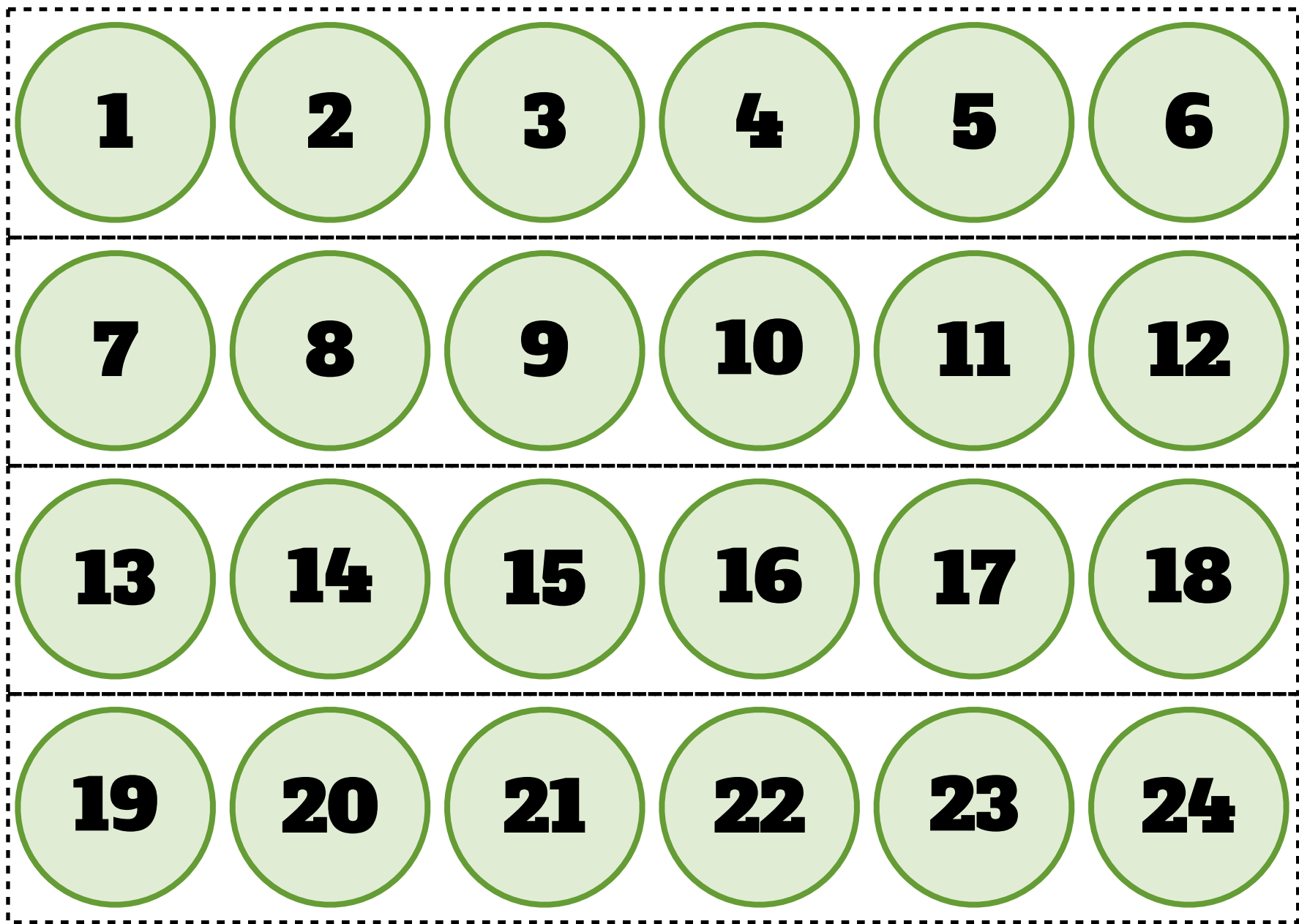
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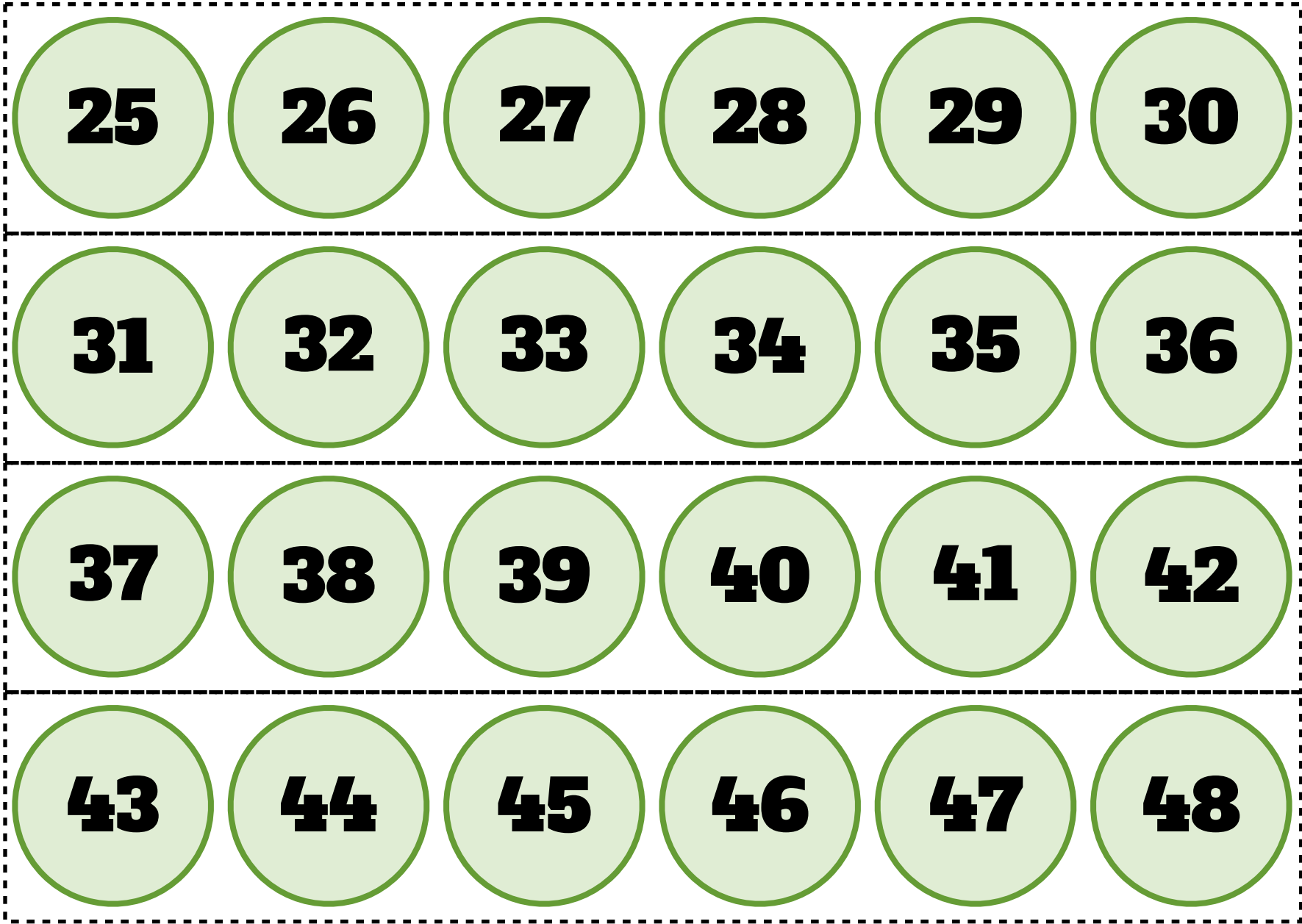


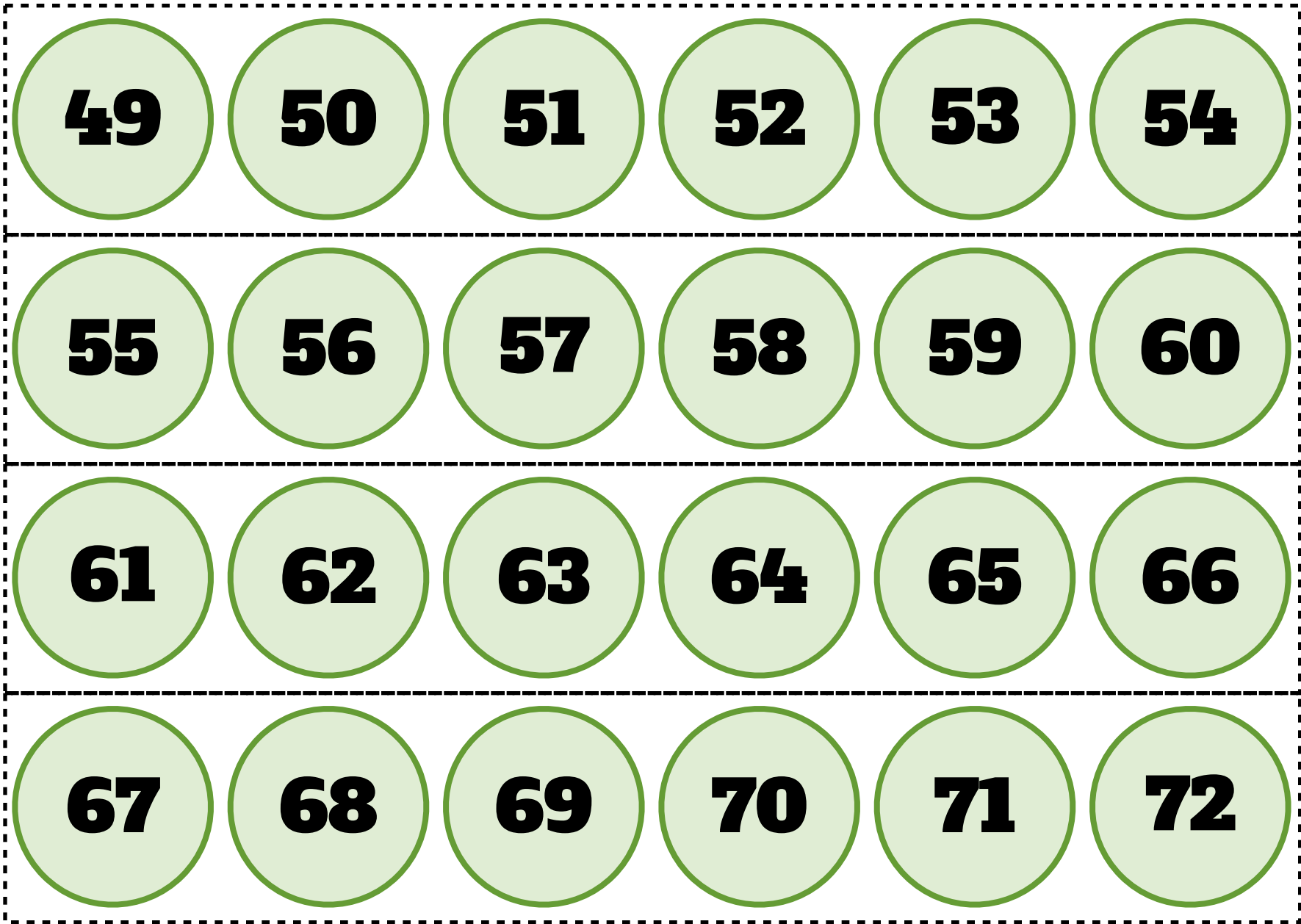
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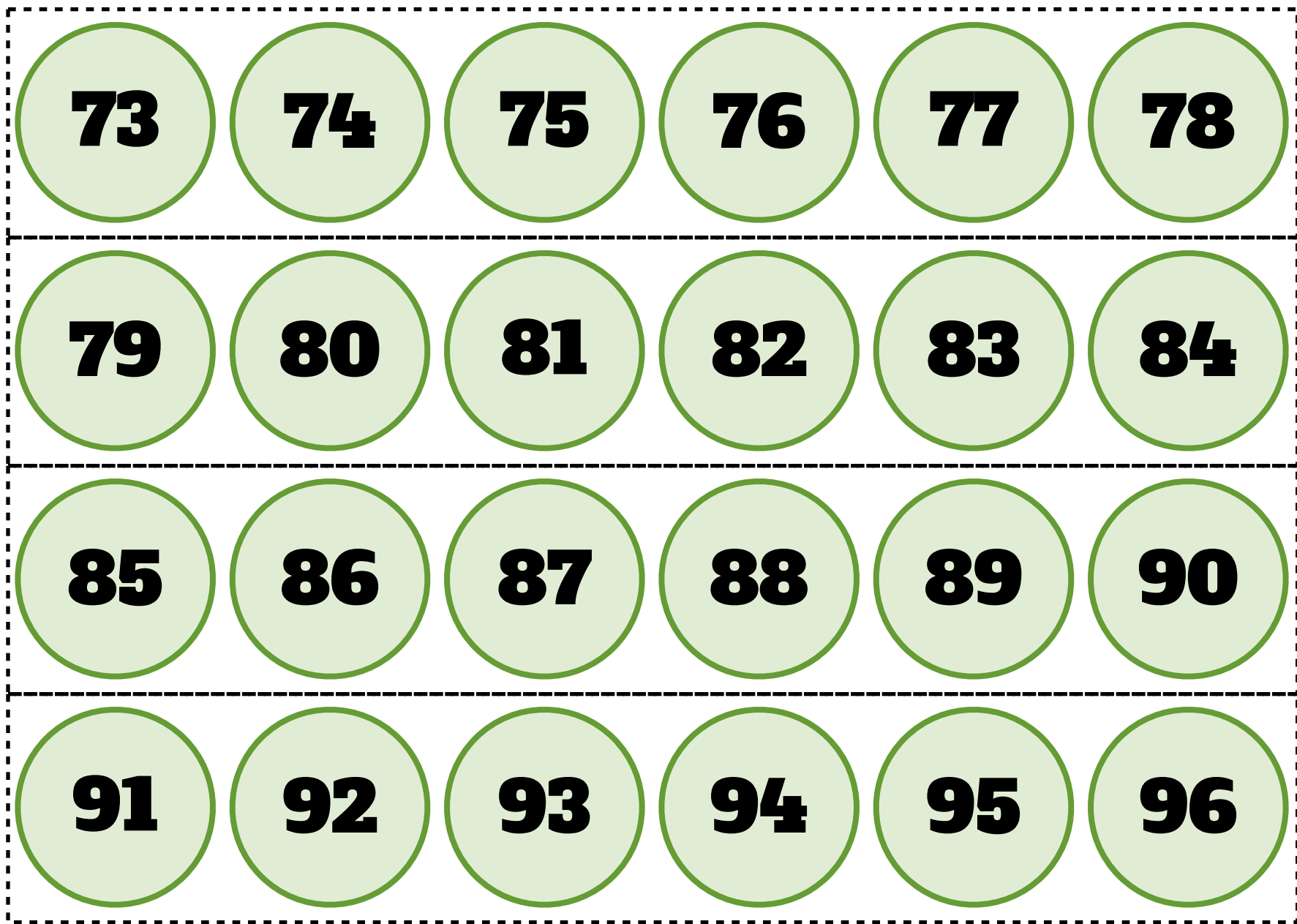
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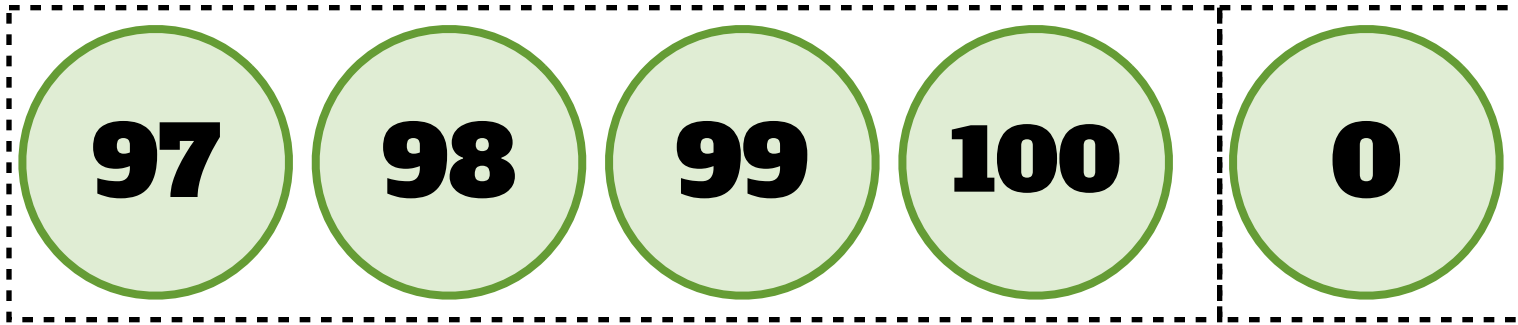


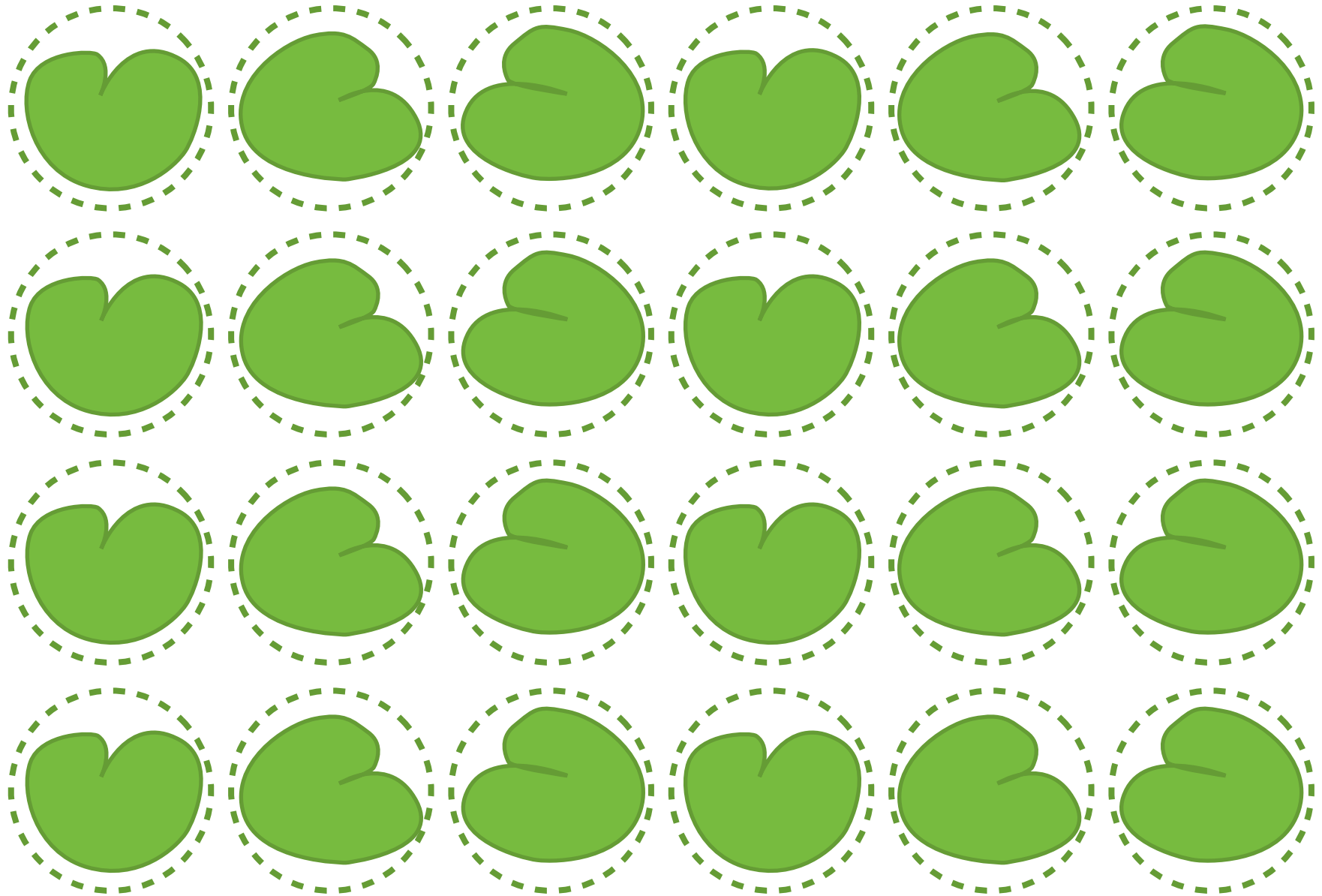












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DIRECTIONS:

HOW TO PLAY NUMBER JUMPERS:

These are just a few suggestions for using these cards. Come up with your own ideas to get even more fun and use out of them.

- **TARGET COUNTING:** Put a lily pad on the target number you want students to count to. They take turns counting, moving their frogs one step at a time until they reach the target number. If they make a mistake, have them repeat the correct number and start over.
- **LEAPFROG COUNTING:** Put a lily pad on the target counting number you want students to count to. 2 or more students take turns reading numbers as they move along, leapfrog jumping over each other to take turns. For example, if student A reads the number 1, student B jumps his frog to number 2, and then student A (or C if you have more than 2 students) would jump over the others and read number 3...
- **SKIP COUNTING:** Put lily pads on multiples of 2, 3, 4, 5 (or other desired skip counting). Students will jump the other numbers to get to the lily pads and say the numbers that are hidden under the lily pads. Counting by multiples as far as you want to.
