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DIRECTIONS:

Print out the cards on pages 1-6. Cut following the dotted lines.

If you print them out on heavy paper they may last longer.

Laminate if possible for better wear.

IDEAS FOR USING THE CARDS:

These are just a few suggestions for using these cards. Come up with your own ideas to get even more fun and use out of them.

- **KNOW YOUR WORDS:** Draw a card. Practice saying the words on the cards.
- **SORT YOUR WORDS:** Say the words and sort them into categories like: has an o, starts with a vowel, starts with a consonant, etc... You make up the categories.
- **WORDSEARCH:** Read a short story, book, or article. Find as many of these words as you can in the story. Keep two piles of the cards, 1 for the words you found and 1 for the words you did not find. Or, display all the cards on the table. As you read and find them, turn them over.
- **USE YOUR WORDS:** Choose a card at random. Use it in a sentence.
