## **DIRECTIONS:**

#### Get more free materials!

To make this booklet, print the cover first. Fold it in half. This makes the cover folder. Students can put a picture or sketch of themselves on the back cover and illustrate the front cover!

Then print the next 4 pages front and back. That will make the first leaf of the booklet. Tuck them inside one another and make sure the letters are in order. When they are correct, slide the leaf into the cover.

Print the next 4 pages of lower case letters and do the same as the last leaf. Insert that one after the first leaf. With the booklet closed, staple twice through the cover and both leaves close to the binding. This should make a booklet you can flip through.

DO NOT PRINT THIS PAGE.

#### **NOTES:**

Depending on your printer's settings, you might be better off printing all the even pages, putting them back in the tray, and then printing the odd pages on the backs.

Another, perhaps easier way, is to print all the pages single-sided. Glue two pages together. Page 2, which contains booklet pages 8 and 1, will get glued on the blank side of Page 3, which has booklet pages 2 and 7. DO NOT PRINT THIS PAGE.
