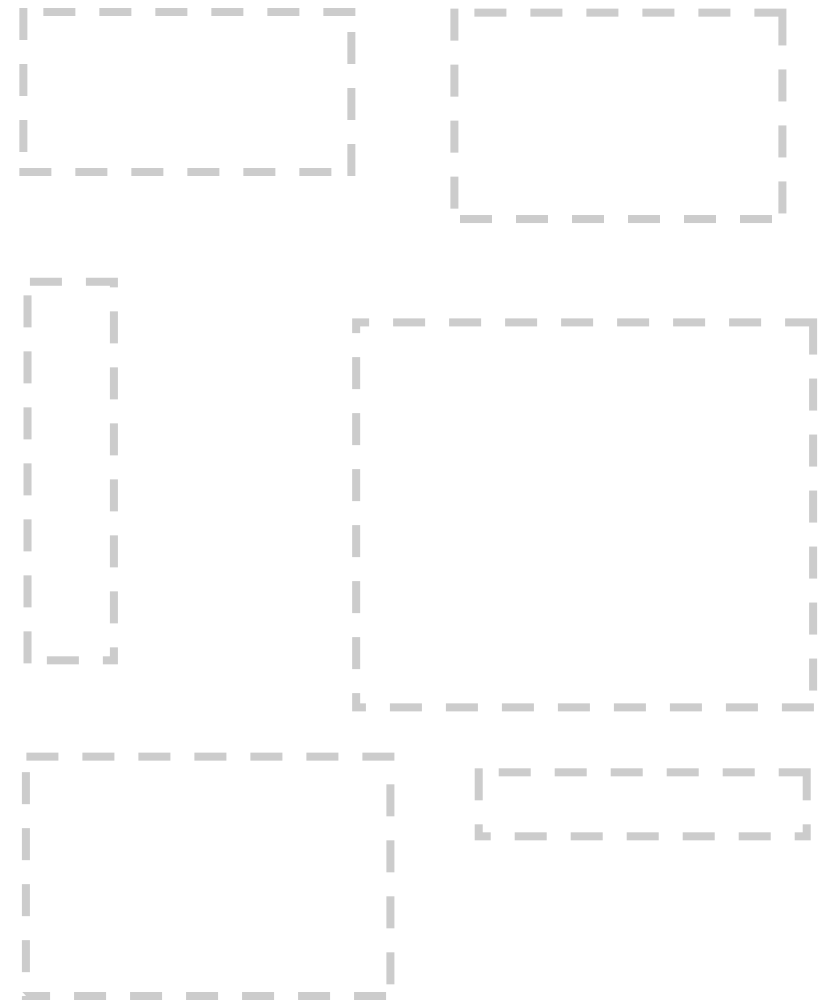
SQUARES

They have 4 sides of the same length.
They have right angle squared corners.
The lines are in parallel pairs.



RECTANGLES

There are 2 pairs of sides with the same lengths.
They have right angle squared corners.
The lines are in parallel pairs.

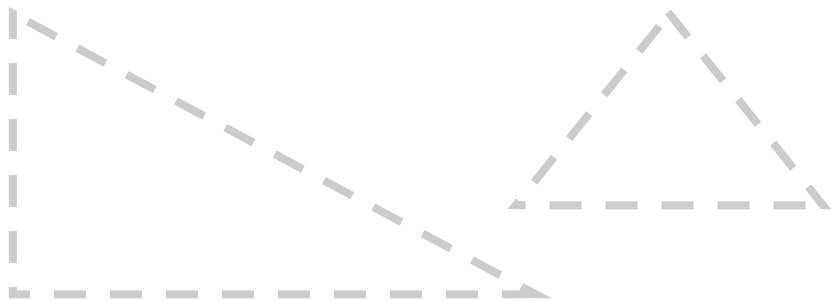
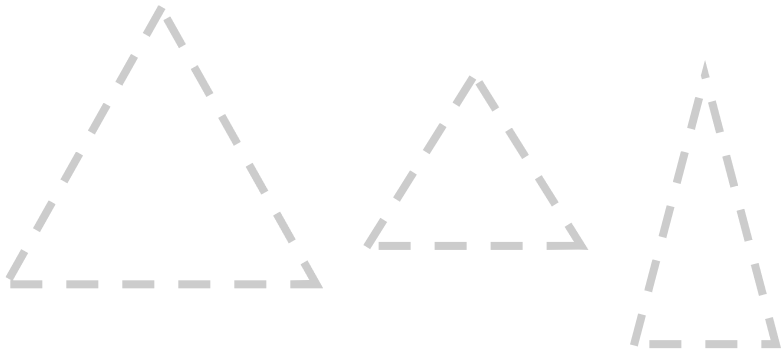


TRIANGLES

They have 3 sides.

Sometimes they sides are different lengths.

Sometimes they have a right angle.

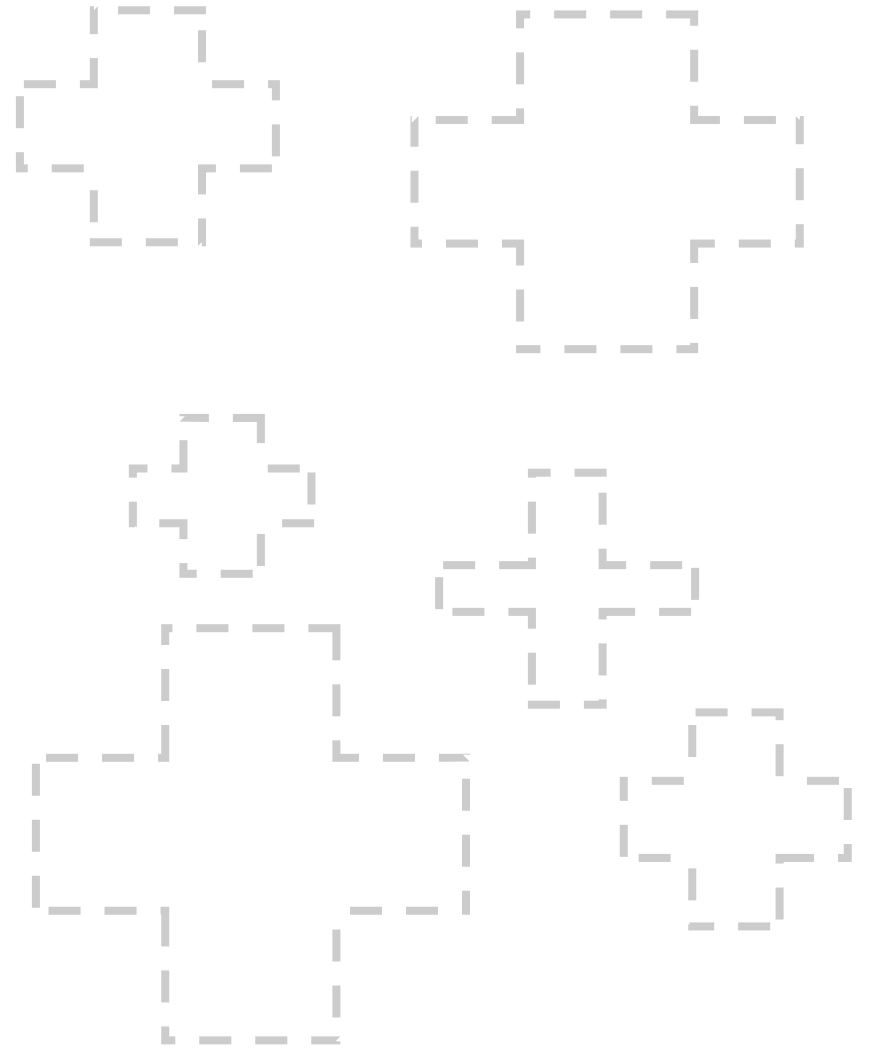


CROSSES

They have 12 sides!

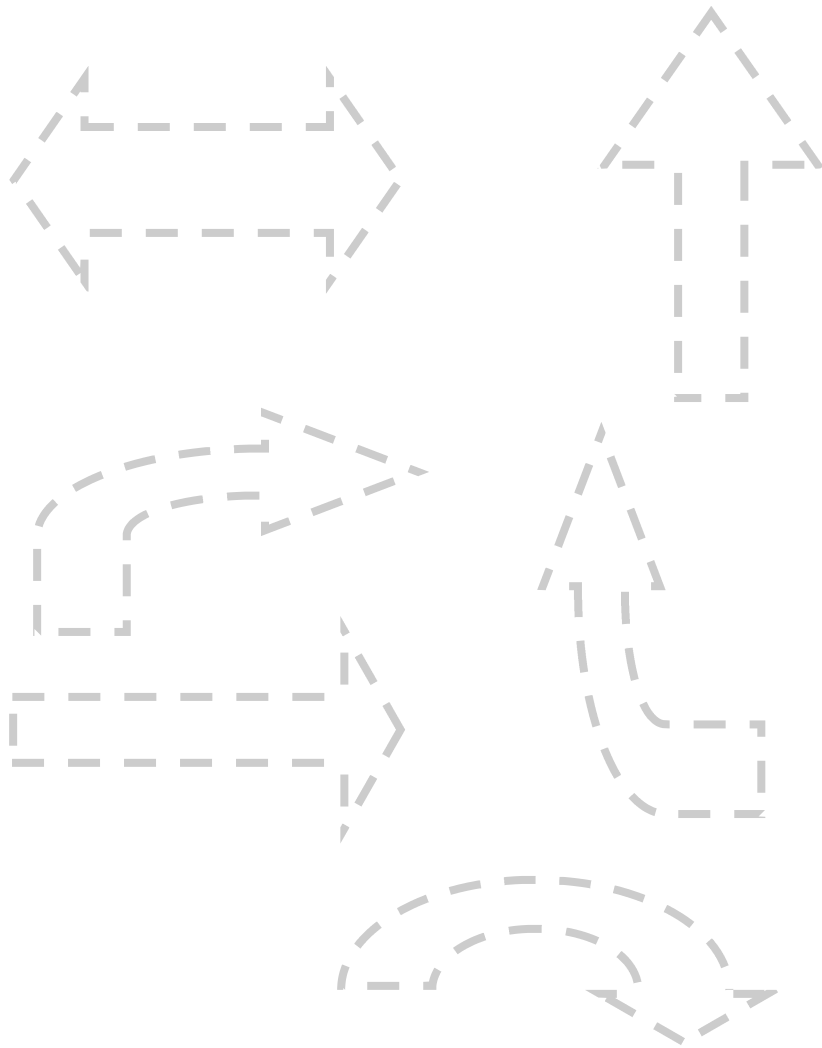
They have 8 right angles.

Their sides can be different lengths.



ARROWS

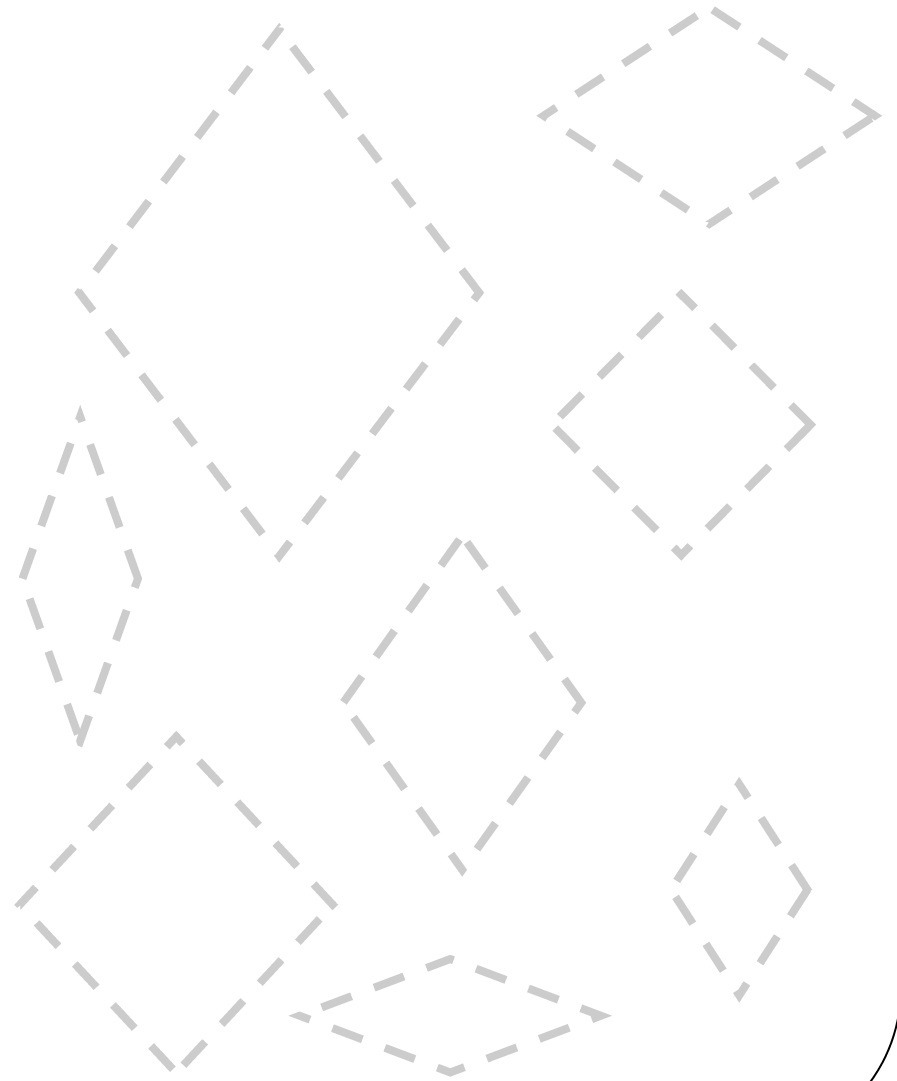
They point in a direction or directions.
They can be straight or curved.



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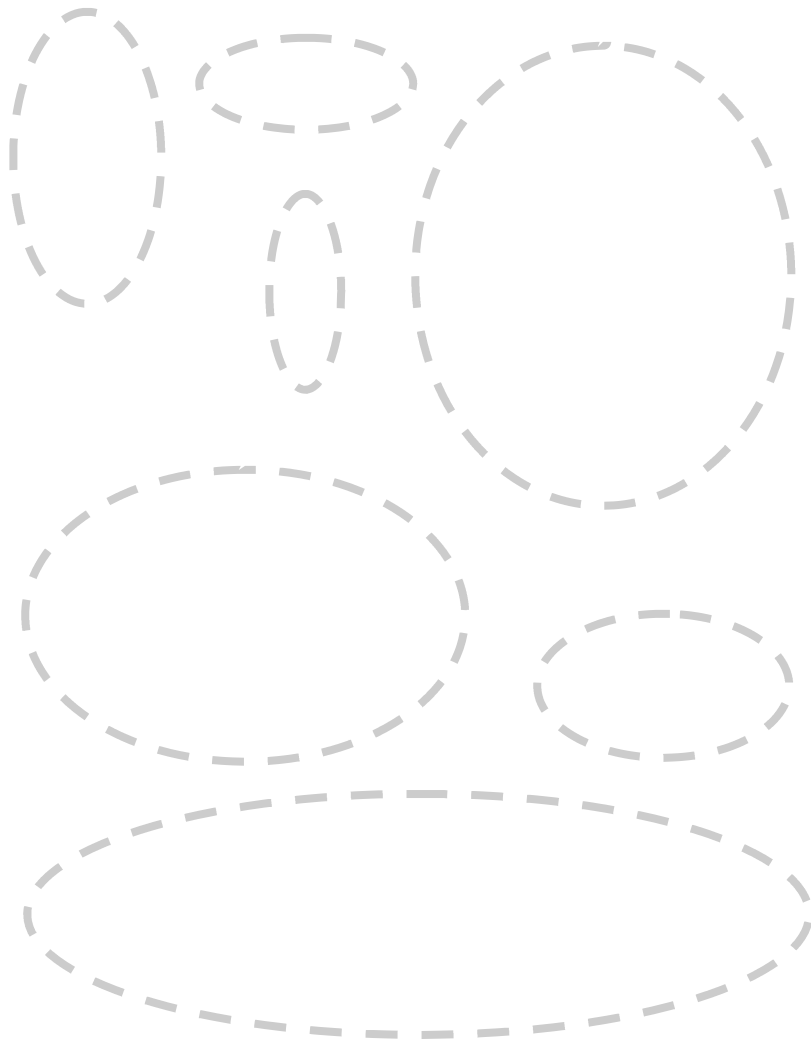
DIAMONDS

They have 4 sides.
They usually don't have right angles.



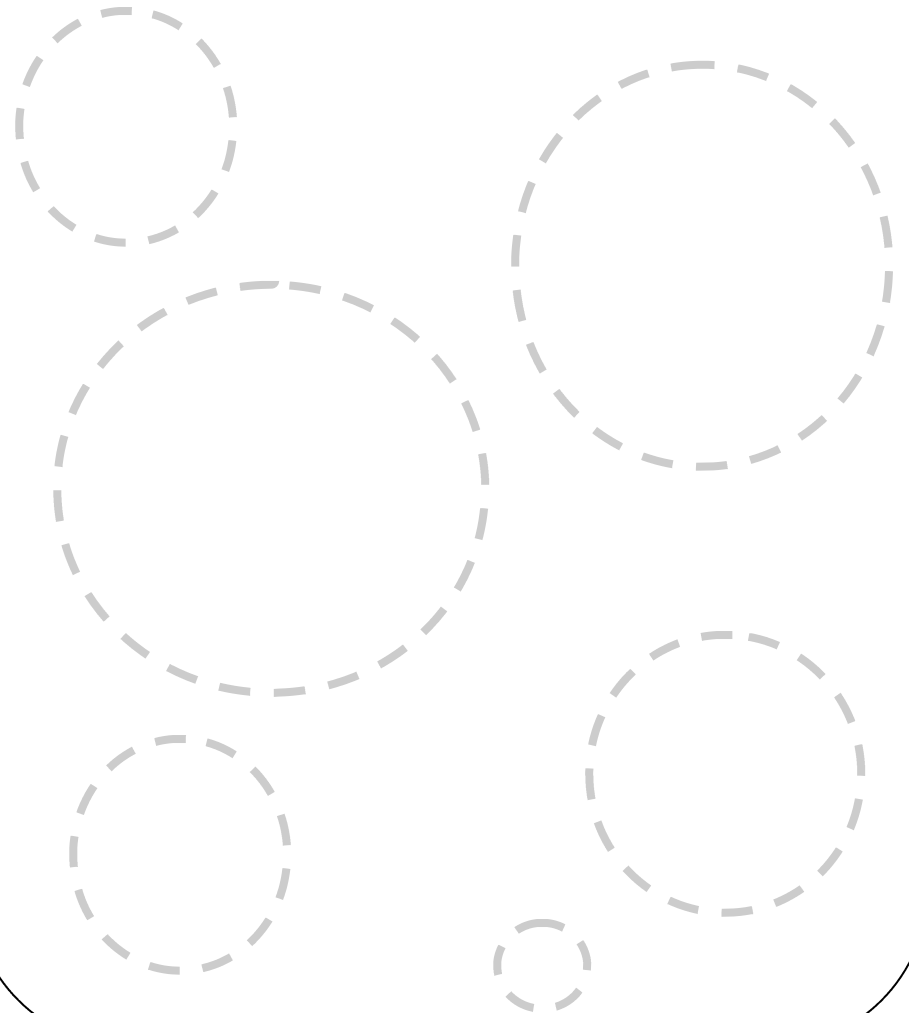
OVALS

They have no straight sides or corners.
They look like squished circles.



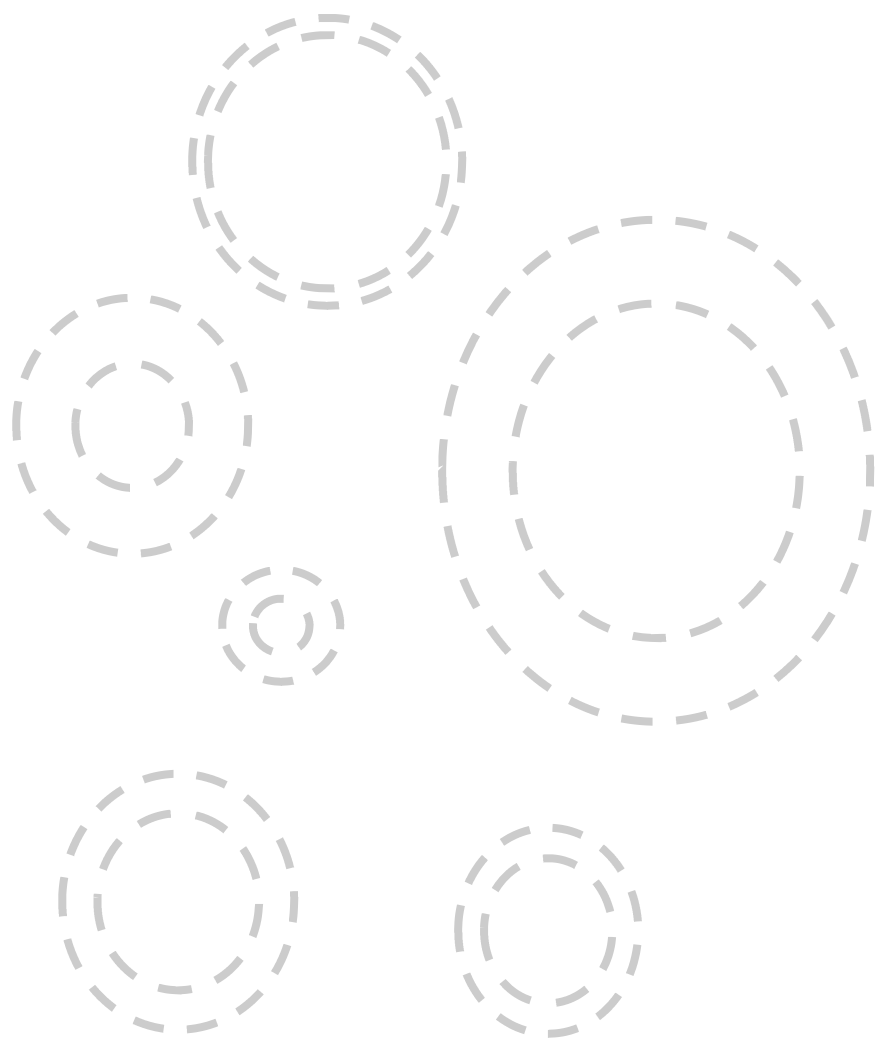
CIRCLES

They have no straight sides or corners.
They are round and can't be squished at all.



RINGS

They have no straight sides or corners.
They look like an inside and an outside circle.



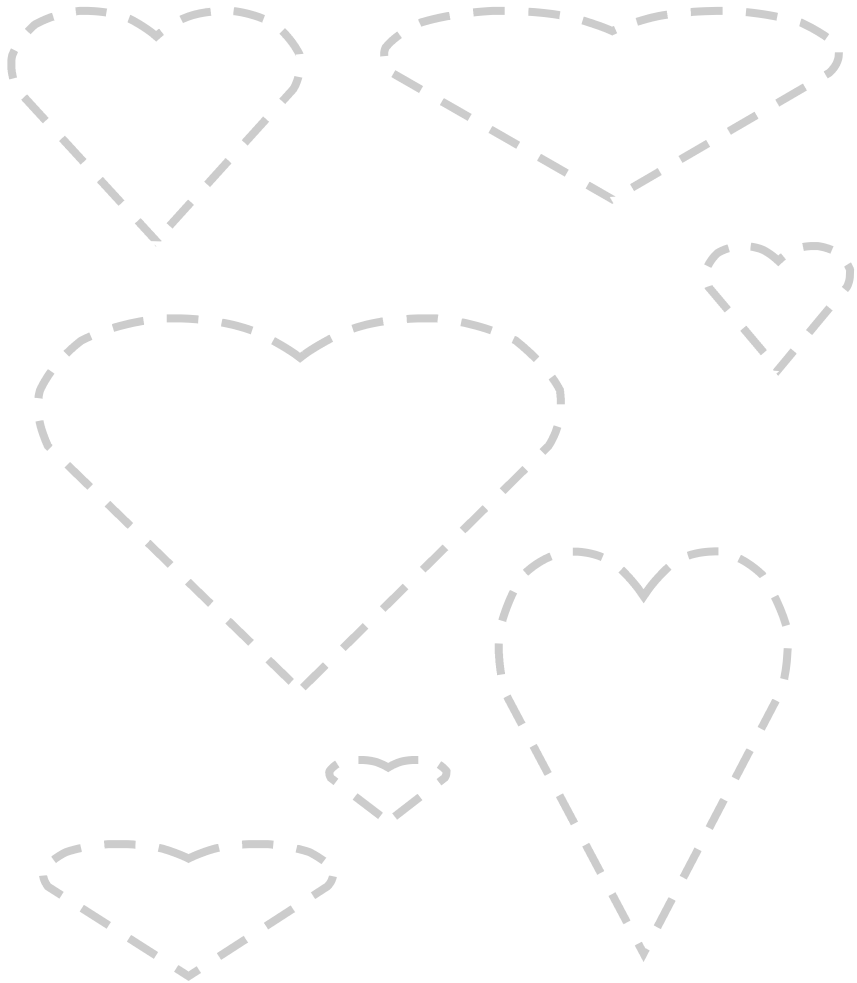
MOONS

They come to two points at the ends.
Sometimes they are thin, but sometimes they are fat.



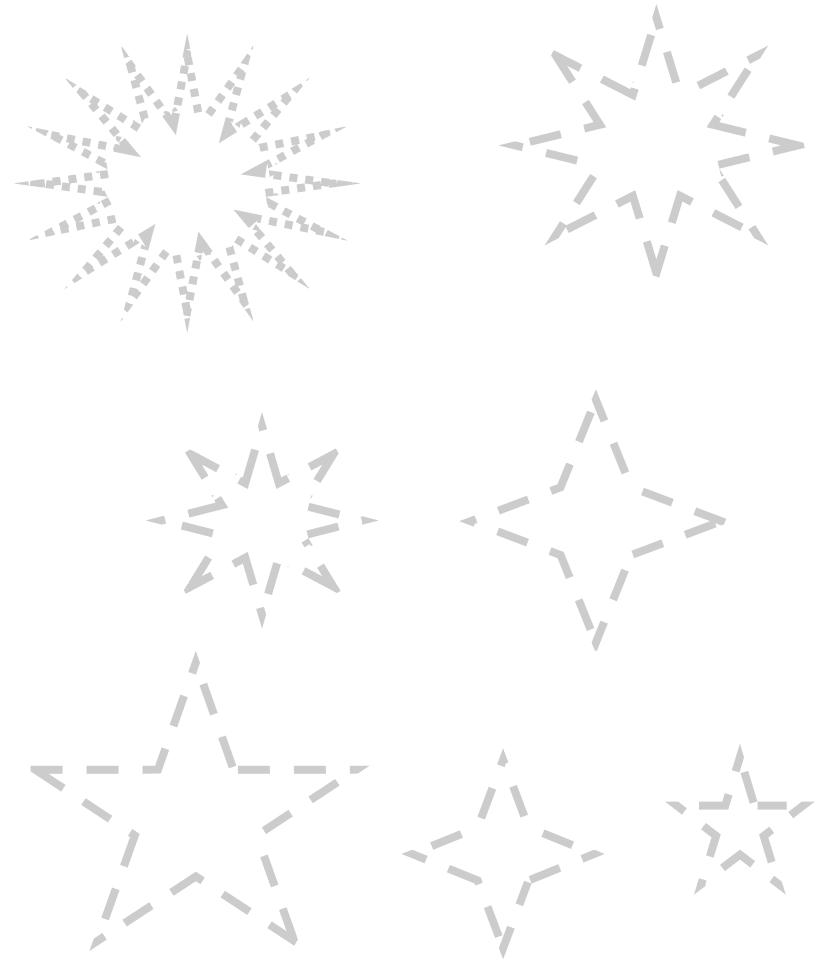
HEARTS

They come to a point on the bottom.
The tops are two rounded bumps.



STARS

Stars come to points.
Usually they have 5 points.
Sometimes they have more or less.



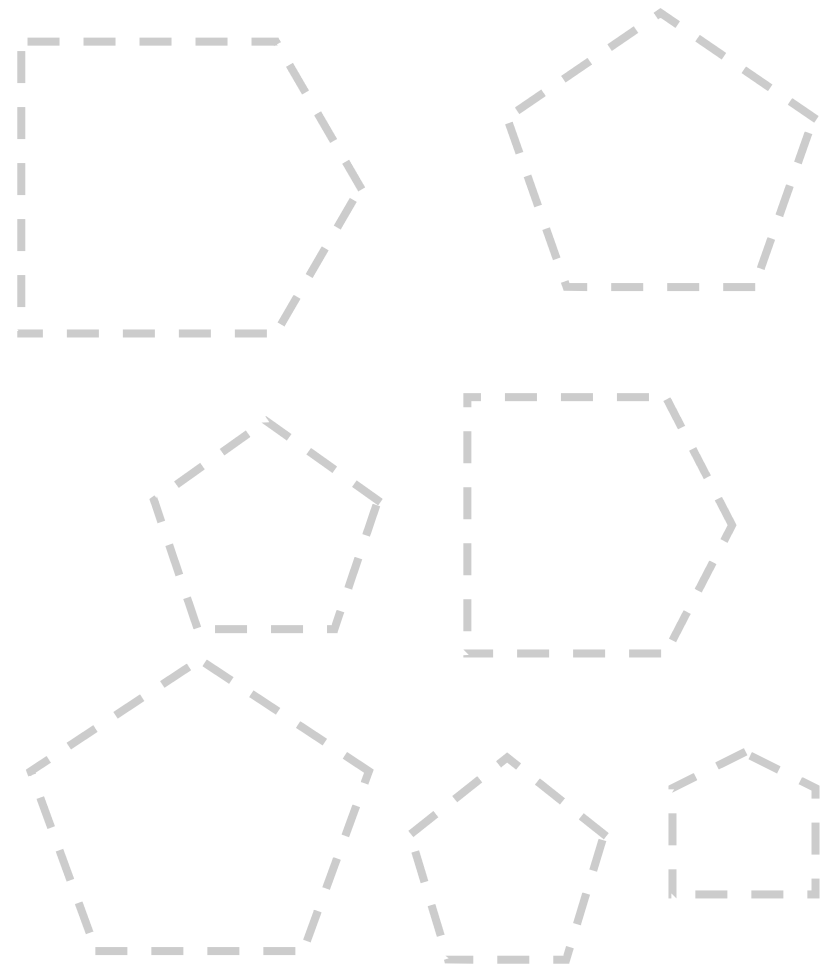
TRAPEZOIDS

Trapezoids have 4 straight sides.
Some of the lines may be parallel.
There may be right angle corners.



PENTAGONS

Pentagons have 5 straight sides.
Some of the lines may be parallel.
There may be right angle corners.



DIRECTIONS:

Print the pages front to back. Fold each in half. Tuck pages 2-8 inside the cover page. Staple along the binding to complete the booklet. Page order doesn't matter, so long as they are all inside the cover. You do not need to print this page.

ACTIVITIES:
